During his 15-year tenure as ED, the Flandreau Santee Sioux Housing Authority was awarded HUD's prestigious Sustained Excellence in Operations award for several years. During that time, Mr. Nibbelink developed nearly \$6 million of new construction in housing and Indian Community Development Block Grant activities.
