Ms. Causley's lifetime passion has been Indian Housing and helping all Tribes provide for our Native People. Ms. Causley is now the Principal of Cheryl A Causley and Associates who offers Housing Consulting and Management Services, and she is a Native American Housing Training & Technical Assistance provider.
